Pictured on every common piece of Mongolian money, Genghis Khan is regarded as the Father of this Nation. In 2006, the country dedicated just outside their government building a statue of Genghis Khan. As pictured above, it is customary for the newly married to have their pictures taken in front of this statue. We have witnessed the bride and groom climbing the many stairs to the statue and then reverently bowing, praying and kissing it's base.

Outside Ulaanbaatar approximately 56 miles, there is a 140 foot Genghis Khan Statue currently being erected. (pictured below) It's size is breath-taking.

Over the last decade, the Ulaanbaatar airport has been renamed as the "Genghis Khan International Airport." Within viewing distance of Ulaanbaatar, stones have been placed on the side of a mountain to produce a huge portrait of Genghis Khan. His name and likeness is endorsed on products, streets and buildings.

Although Genghis Khan has become a central figure in Mongolia's National identity, he is only a substitute. God wants to be the true and living Father of the Mongols. He desires to have a relationship with every person where each will know Him as "Abba Father." **Pray for the Mongolian nation so that every Mongol will respond to God's love and personally declare Him "Father."**
