On June 30th, Mongolia held its 5th General Election. The Communist Party declared victory. However, throughout Ulaanbaatar, Mongolians declared the election results were tampered with and invalid. On July 1st, thousands of people wanting democracy and feeling completely betrayed by unfair voting procedures, assembled outside the Communist headquarters (pictured above) to protest. However, what started in a rather peaceful manner turned violent. The building was stormed by the outraged and disillusioned voters. Rocks were thrown at the windows, fires were started through-out, and property was looted and vandalized. The President immediately declared a "State of Emergency" which was in affect until July 6th restricting all assembling, cancelling all news broadcasting except the government endorsed channel and enacting a curfew.
