Mongolian A/G Training Center Update

Unusually cold weather and snow has been the cause of death for millions of livestock in Mongolia.

The countryside of Mongolia is currently experiencing a white "dzud" - which is a multiple natural disaster consisting of a summer drought followed by a very heavy winter snow and winds. This '09 -'10 winter has killed over 1.7 million livestock .



Temperatures are still dipping as low as -58 F. If the winter conditions don't improve soon, the U.N. Food and Agriculture Organization stated over 4 million livestock could perish by Spring. With over 1/3 of Mongolia's population raising livestock, please pray temperatures will improve and God will provide help for these needy farmers.

While dead livestock are a tragedy (and these pictures depict the physical plight in the land), an even worse tragedy is that many people living in Mongolian are dead in their sin and need to hear the gospel. Jesus alone can bring new life to the lost soul. Thanks for your continued prayer and financial support that helps us train the workers needed to fulfill the task of reaching Mongolia with the LIFE GIVING gospel.
